The Padma Shri is an honor bestowed on a very few who have truly provided distinguished service to the larger community. Recommendations for the award are made to an Awards Committee and approved by the President of India. The Padma Awards are announced on the eve of India's Republic Day.



Throughout his career, Dr. Paul has demonstrated a deep commitment to patient care. He is noted for his pioneering work in Microneurosurgery and advances in medical devices and technology, opening new opportunities for care and treatment where none had existed before.
